1. Should it prove necessary to act on behalf of the principal in tax matters, the Principal will grant a separate authorization to act on behalf of the Principal to the Customs Broker specified by the Customs Agency RADA Sp. z o.o., pursuant to Article 137 (1a) of the Tax Code.
2. The Principal agrees to immediately notify the representative and the relevant customs administration authorities of the withdrawal of this authorisation.
3. The principal of this authorization declares that goods which are the subject of export are not subject to any non-economic limitations.
4. The principal of this authority states that the goods, which are subject to export are not goods of strategic importance within the Act of 29 November 2000 on international trade of goods, technologies and services of strategic importance for the state's safety, as well as for keeping international peace and safety (Journal of Laws No. 119 of 28 December 2000 as amended, unified text – Journal of Laws No. 229 of 2004, item 2315) and they are not listed in the list of dual-use items (Council Regulation (EC) No. 428/2009 of 5 May 2009 as amended) and are not present in the current military goods controls specified under the above mentioned act on the date of shipment export.
5. The principal of this authority states that the goods, which are subject to export are not covered by the Washington Convention CITES.
6. The principal of this authority states that the goods, which are subject to export are not waste within the meaning of the Regulation (EC) No. 1013/2006 (Journal of Laws L 190) on shipment of waste.
7. In the event when any of the points 3-6 does not comply with the statement, the Principal of this authority undertakes to inform about it the customs agency RADA SP.Z.O.O. in a separate statement presenting the required permit.
8. At the same time, the principal of this authorization assumes responsibility for:
  - reliability of invoice translation into Polish (if necessary)
  - compliance of goods with documents as to quantity, weight, type, value number, model, type, series and other markings
  - meet the deadlines established in the course of the proceedings
  - providing all information as well as documents necessary for the proper performance of services in the scope of the power of attorney granted.
9. At the same time, I consent to the processing of my personal data in the scope in the power of attorney granted by RADA Sp. z o.o. 22-100 Chełm, ul. Wschodnia 23B in order to perform all activities covered by this authorization, before customs authorities.
